

SCHOOL-SUPPORT ORGANIZATIONS

The board encourages the formation of a parent-teacher-student association or similar organization at each school for the purpose of providing an opportunity through which parents, teachers and students may unite their efforts and interests to enhance the school program. In schools where no such organization exists, another parent group may be recognized by the school principal as the official body through which parents, staff and students may unite their efforts for like purposes.

Booster clubs and/or special interest organizations may be formed to support and strengthen specific activities within the school or district. All such groups shall receive the approval of the school principal or superintendent and shall adhere to Washington state laws and district policies and procedures in order to be a recognized booster organization. Staff participation, cooperation and support are encouraged in such recognized organizations.
