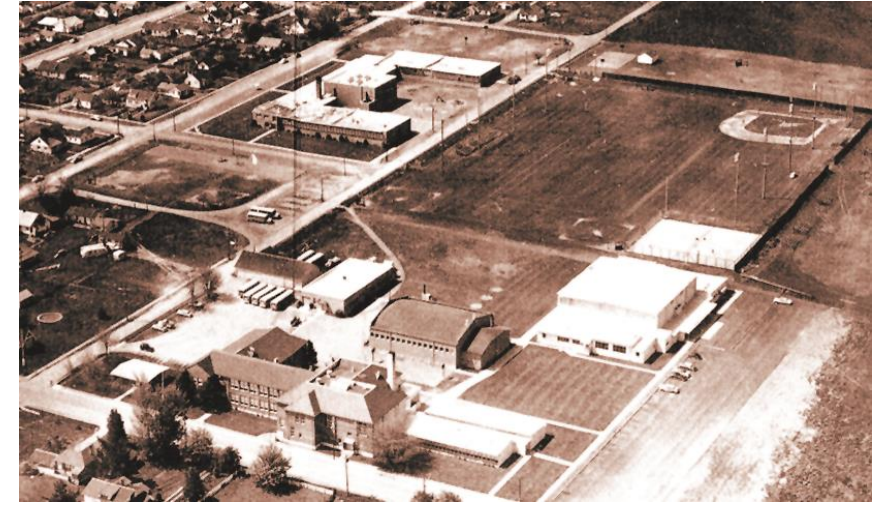

In 2012, programs began moving from the Community School into other spaces in the District as they became available. Building systems were decommissioned and now the building awaits demolition. Funding must be secured to continue with demolition. The District anticipates that demolition of the building will result in **\$4.3 million in state matching funds** made available to assist with construction costs associated with elementary school improvements.

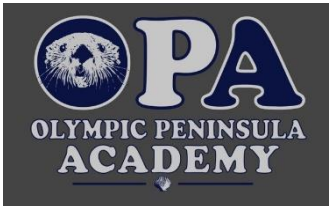
