



## Action on Legislative Proposals

- 47 Proposals were addressed (5 areas) Learning, Teaching, Leadership, Governance, and Funding & Allocations
- 2 were voted for elimination or combined with others under streamlining
- 7 new proposals; 5 were approved; 1 combined under streamlining; 1 was not passed (Access to Collective Bargaining Agreements)
- 3 were amended with word changes.
- 37 passed as recommended by the Legislative Committee
